APPS: TAG READERS and PADI

Scuba enthusiasts can go green and get more and more information on their digital devices, thanks to the growing number of apps. I found two very useful ones, which you can download for free on your Smart phone, I Pod or I Pad. The first one is the PADI app, which helps you find dive operators, locate them on a map, provide their contact info, using a choice of options, including using your current location.

Another excellent app is the free Tag Reader application. If, like me, you are an avid reader of Dive Training Magazine, you will have noticed their numerous tags. Just point your device's camera

to the tag, and in milliseconds it will automatically open a webpage related to the article you were reading, providing more detail than could fit in the magazine's article.


Once you have scanned a tag, it saves automatically, and you can access the site by hitting the history button. It is a very practical tool for trips to dive destinations. 
